Main Street Accreditation Visit is 1/23/25

Each year, Historic Downtown Kendallville (HDK) is visited by representatives from Indiana Main Street to review and assess our status as a nationally accredited Main Street. As part of this process, various discussion groups are scheduled throughout the day to participate and share their perspective.

The overall goal of these discussions is to:

- 1. Celebrate the progress and accomplishments of the past, and identify best practices that could be replicated in other communities across the state.
- 2. Provide consultation on implementing the Main Street Approach and the organization's Transformation Strategy (as a reminder, our strategy is FAMILY-FRIENDLY).
- 3. Eliminate barriers to achieving community and organizational goals.
- 4. Assess the organization's progress within the National Accreditation Standards.

This year, our annual visit is scheduled for **Thursday**, **January 23rd**.

Below is an overview of each session that will be held throughout the day.

9:30 -10:00 Conversation with Executive Director

10:00 –10:50 Conversation with key community partners (Chamber, EDC, colleges, other non-profits, and city leaders)

11:00 – 11:50 Conversation with community historic preservation partners (city HPC, city planning, historical society, and building owners)

1:30 – 1:50 Conversation with board executive committee


2:00 – 2:50 Conversation with full board of directors
