RDC Providing Roofing Grants

The Kendallville Redevelopment Commission (RDC), recognizing that maintaining a commercial roof is essential to ensuring the structural integrity of historic buildings, recently voted to launch a new roofing grant program for downtown Kendallville property owners.

The program provides a 95% match for roof repair and replacement, along with gutters and downspouts. Property owners are required to obtain three bids for the roof work, and the RDC will provide a match grant for the lowest of the three, up to \$50,000.
